Introduction

In this report, we explore the key trends and significant M&A transactions in the Workforce Solutions industry during the first and second quarters of 2024. Following the challenging conditions of 2023, which was marked by a significant decline in transaction volumes amid macroeconomic pressures, the market started to recover in the latter half of the year, with growth momentum continuing into the first half of 2024.

- Commercial Staffing, encompassing both white- and blue-collar roles across diverse
 industries, remained the most active sub-sector, accounting for 26% of all recorded deals.
 IT Staffing took second place, comprising 12% of the total deal volume, or 27
 transactions, showing signs of recovery after a significant decline in 2023 as demand for
 IT roles begins to stabilize.
- Geographically, North America led in M&A activity with the highest number of buyers and targets, while Europe maintained a strong position, capturing a significant share of transactions. The Asia-Pacific region also demonstrated notable activity, particularly in Japan, which showed strong buyer and target engagement.

This report provides a comprehensive analysis of the latest M&A activity in the Workforce Solutions industry over the past six months.





TRANSACTION ACTIVITY | OVERVIEW



M&A Overview

After a challenging 2023, marked by a decade-low drop in transactions in the second quarter due to macroeconomic pressures, the market began to recover in the latter half of the year, with steady improvement in transaction volumes continuing into the first and second quarters of 2024. This report highlights 48 of the 219 M&A transactions in workforce solutions completed during the first half of 2024. The first quarter of 2024 recorded 102 transactions, followed by 117 in the second quarter, reflecting a positive trend in market activity compared to the previous year's figures.

Non-specialist Commercial Staffing continued to lead as the most active sub-sector, accounting for 26% of identified deals with 58 transactions, followed by specialist IT Staffing with 12% of the total deal volume or 27 transactions. Place & Search subsector experienced a notable rise, increasing from 6% to 10% (21 transactions), while Professional Staffing saw a decline from 15% to 9% of total deal volume (20 transactions).

Cross-border transactions made up 18% of the deals recorded, representing a further decline from the 23% observed in H2 2023. Geographically, North America exhibited the highest level of M&A activity, with 103 (47%) buyers and 96 (43%) targets. Europe ranked second, capturing 37% of buyers and 38% of targets, with the United Kingdom and the Netherlands being the most targeted countries, reflecting 28 and 14 completed deals, respectively. The Asia-Pacific region accounted for 15% of buyers and 17% of targets, with Japan standing out with 25 completed deals. Strategic buyers accounted for the vast majority (89%) of all M&A transactions in the period.

As is typical in private M&A transactions, the majority of deal terms were not made public. Aggregate disclosed deal values rose significantly from \$1.4bn in H2 2023 to \$5.0bn in H1 2024. For the limited number of transactions where metrics were disclosed, the average deal size was \$219.0 million, while no EBITDA multiples were made available for any deals. Companies listed in the sector are currently trading at an average EV/EBITDA multiple of 9.3x.

Rebuilding IT with Specialized Talent

Following the turbulent period of layoffs and restructuring that characterized the 2023 IT landscape, the demand for specialized IT expertise is rebounding, with a renewed focus on agile, project-based workforces. As the market stabilizes in 2024 and organizations continue to adapt to a digital-first world, the importance of having access to specialized IT talent cannot be overstated. This resurgence is evident in H1 2024, with IT staffing representing 12% of the total deal volume, ranking as the second-largest sub-sector after Commercial Staffing.

Organizations are now focused on rebuilding their IT capabilities by strategically hiring specialized roles to drive digital transformation. Instead of broad hiring practices, companies are targeting niche tech skills, such as cybersecurity, cloud computing, and AI, to meet specific business needs. The 2023 layoffs exposed vulnerabilities in cybersecurity and compliance, prompting a shift towards recruiting skilled IT professionals with expertise in these areas to protect against emerging threats and ensure regulatory compliance in a rapidly evolving digital landscape.

Flexible staffing models, including hybrid and remote work, are continuing to gain traction. Firms specializing in IT staffing have a significant opportunity to support this transition. Companies increasingly recognize the benefits of partnering with staffing firms that offer tailored services to specific sectors within the IT industry.

In the first half of 2024, there were 27 IT staffing transactions. *Bizztalent*, a provider of IT support and infrastructure services, was acquired by *Planet Group*, a provider of outsourced human capital and consulting services seeking to strengthen its focus on flexible and temporary staffing for the IT sector, including areas such as support, systems, and network engineering. Additionally, *Motion Recruitment Partners*, a provider of IT staffing services focused on skilled, difficult-to-fill positions, was acquired by *Kelly Services*, a recruitment firm that provides workforce support through an array of outsourcing, consulting, and staffing services, for \$485 million.




